# Ten Tips for a Good Lent (and Beyond)

### PRAYER

1. Daily Prayer

Have a regular prayer rule for morning and evening prayer.

- 2. Worship and Participation in the Sacraments Attend Mass receiving Holy Communion regularly and go to Confession.
- 3. Daily Reading

Be inspired by the lessons of the Holy Scripture, as set for daily Mass, and the lives of the Saints of the Church.

4. The Rosary and the Jesus Prayer Say a decade of the Rosary every day and repeat the Jesus Prayer (*Lord Jesus, Son of God: have mercy on me a sinner*) whenever possible.

## FASTING

- 5. The Liturgical Cycle of the Church Follow the seasons of the church and participate in the fasts and feasts of the Church.
- 6. An Orderly Life

Set priorities and reduce the stress and friction caused by a hurried life. Give full attention to what you are doing at the moment. Taming the Passions

Overcome your habits, attachment to your likes and dislikes, and learn to practise the virtues.

## 8. Giving

Give generously of your time, talents, and money.

- Putting Others First Free yourself from your selfishness and find joy in helping others.
- 10. Spiritual Fellowship

Spend time regularly with other Christians for support and inspiration.
