Gospel John 1:35-39

John the Baptist was standing with two of his followers when he saw Jesus walking by. "There is the Lamb of God," he said, looking at Jesus. On hearing this, the two men left John and followed Jesus.

Seeing what they were following him, Jesus turned and asked, "What do you want with me?"

"We would like to know where you live," they answered. "Come with me and see," Jesus said. So, they followed him to his house and stayed with him for the rest of the day.
